FISH CONSUMPTION ADVISORY**

**LEAD ADVISORY FOR SPRING RIVER AND THE GRAND LAKE
WATERSHED BELOW TAR CREEK:**

NON GAME FISH

(DRUM, CARP, REDHORSE SUCKER, SMALLMOUTH BUFFALO):

- **SPRING RIVER:** 3 meals/month prepared with bones, **9 meals/month of filets**
- **NEOSHO RIVER:** 8 meal per month with bones
- **GRAND LAKE:** 6 meals/month prepared with bones

GAME FISH

(CRAPPIE, BASS):

NO RESTRICTIONS FROM SPRING RIVER, NEOSHO RIVER, OR GRAND LAKE

SUNFISH

- **SPRING RIVER:** 5 meals/month prepared with bones
- **NEOSHO RIVER or GRAND LAKE:** NO RESTRICTIONS

CATFISH

- **SPRING RIVER:** 9 meals/month prepared with bones
- **NEOSHO RIVER or GRAND LAKE:** NO RESTRICTIONS

**NO MERCURY ADVISORY FOR FISH CONSUMPTION FOR SPRING
RIVER OR GRAND LAKE.**
