NON GAME FISH

(DRUM, CARP, REDHORSE SUCKER, SMALLMOUTH BUFFALO):

- SPRING RIVER: 3 meals/month prepared with bones, 9 meals/month of filets
- **NEOSHO RIVER:** 8 meal per month with bones
- **GRAND LAKE:** 6 meals/month prepared with bones

GAME FISH

(CRAPPIE, BASS):

NO RESTRICTIONS FROM SPRING RIVER, NEOSHO RIVER, OR GRAND LAKE

SUNFISH

- SPRING RIVER: 5 meals/month prepared with bones
- NEOSHO RIVER or GRAND LAKE: NO RESTRICTIONS

CATFISH

- **SPRING RIVER:** 9 meals/month prepared with bones
- NEOSHO RIVER or GRAND LAKE: NO RESTRICTIONS

NO MERCURY ADVISORY FOR FISH CONSUMPTION FOR SPRING RIVER OR GRAND LAKE.
