RE: Reserve Academy 18 BR 1-1

The Pre-Academy will begin on Wednesday October 24, 2018 at 1800 hours at the Eastern Shawnee Tribal Police Department Room.

The 2018 Reserve Officer Basic Academy is scheduled to begin on Monday November 01, 2018 at 1800 hours at the Eastern Shawnee Tribal Police Department Room.

Typically classes are scheduled to begin at 1800 hours and continue until 2200 hours on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday night unless otherwise noted. I suggest you bring with you a blue 3-ring binder. If you would like to bring a laptop computer. That will be allowed. A complete calendar of classes and their corresponding dates will be given the first day of class. The final examination is currently scheduled to take place on Thursday May 30, 2019.

There will be no cost for the Academy. In addition, there will be a cost for the CPR/First Aid Training on October 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> 2018. The cost will be \$45 dollars cash. You do not have to attend both days. Just attend one.

Academy uniform is Khaki slacks (Dockers, 5.11 gear, etc....) and a dark navy blue polo type shirt with no Logo. The shirt can either be short or long sleeved. No jacket or coat with inappropriate logos will be allowed; Department issued coat and jackets will be allowed.

In addition to the cost for CPR/First Aid you will need to acquire a minimum of 1000 rounds of handgun ammunition and a maximum of 35 rounds of 12-gauge 9 pellet OO buckshot (8 pellet OO buck IS NOT acceptable) and a maximum of 35 rounds of 12-gauge 1oz rifled slugs and 50 rounds of 12-gauge birdshot. Only firearms of reputable make and model and in good repair will be acceptable during the firearms portion of the Academy. You will need a 12-gauge police model shotgun (Remington and Mossberg Only). It is highly recommended the shotgun be equipped with the sling. The duty gear (holsters and magazine pouches) must be of good quality in good safe condition and made for the weapon you will use during this academy. Also it's the Students or Agency responsibility to purchase CLEET approved shooting TARGET'S. They will need 100 targets per-person.

For the custody and control portion of this Academy you will need duty gear including a gun belt, holster, cuff case, handcuffs (reputable make hinged or chain) and a handcuff key. Uniform for this

portion of the class will be gray sweat pants and a plain white t-shirt. Your last name will be written on printed in black across the upper back section of the shirt's shoulders.

## FIREARMS

Note: Do not bring firearms to class until told to do so

(NO RELOADED OR REMANUFACTURED AMMUNITON WILL BE ALLOWED)

Handgun of reputable make, model and caliber of 9mm or greater

- > Minimum of three magazines
- > Appropriate holster with retention device and in good working order
- > Appropriate magazine pouch (2-slot) in good working order
- > Duty belt in good working order.

12 gauge police pump action shotgun (18" or 20" barrel) Remington or Mossberg

- Attached sling
- Sidesaddle (optional)

Ammunition Quantities

- 1000 rounds of pistol ammunition in a caliber consistent with their handgun
- 35 rounds of 12ga. 9 pellet OO buck (8 pellet OO buck IS NOT acceptable)
- 35 rounds of 12ga. Slug ammunition
- 50 rounds of 12ga. Birdshot

TARGETS- It's the Student or Agency responsibility to buy their on Target. That is approved by CLEET.

The Target's is what the Students shoot at the Range.

The Agency can call CLEET or go to the CLEET Website for Information on what TARGET to buy.

The CLEET approve Targets are: Oklahoma CLEET B-27, SKU B-27 GM

They will need 100 Targets per-person.

Estimate cost for shipping 100Qy \$16.51 and cost for Targets \$29.00 Total= \$45.51 100Qy Targets

This is only a Estimate to give the Student and Agency a price range

### Specification for Handgun ammunition

- American manufactured ammunition consistent with projectile grain weight, and ballistic performance of their “duty” ammunition
- Ammunition must be loaded to SAAMI specification (Sporting Arms and Ammunition Manufacturers Institute)
- Acceptable manufacturers: (examples)
  - Remington
  - Winchester
  - Federal
  - Speer

### Specification for Shotgun ammunition

- American Manufactured ammunition consistent with projectile grain weight, and ballistic performance of their “duty” ammunition
- Ammunition must be loaded to SAAMI Specifications (Sporting Arms and Ammunition Manufacturers Institute)
- 12ga. Buckshot must be 9 pellet
- 12ga. Slug must be 1 oz. Slug
- Acceptable Manufacturers (examples)
  - Remington
  - Winchester
  - Federal
  - Speer

### Range Gear

- Eye protection
- Ear protection
- Flashlight (night fire)
- Pen or marker
- Ball cap (boonie cap is acceptable) must have a brim
- Cleaning kit for handgun and shotgun
- Drinks and snacks (optional but recommended)
- Appropriate clothing to include rain gear and / or sun block & chopstick

## CUSTODY & CONTROL

Note; An Exercise routine is recommended prior to this training, begin now to prevent injury. Not strength training; exercise ie. Running, Walking, Stretching, calisthenics

### Uniform

- Gray Sweatpants
- White Tee-shirt (long or short sleeve)
  - Your last name written in black across the back shoulder area
  - Your first name written in black on the left front chest area
- White Socks
- Wrestling type shoes (optional)

### Equipment

- Duty belt including holster, magazine pouch, cuff case and baton holder
- Expandable or straight baton
- Handcuffs, chain or hinged (chain preferred)
- Handcuff key
- Sports drink and snacks (optional)
- Head Gear
